

GRAPHIC INTERFACE TRANSPARENT

Find in which case you fit

Do you own a video card?

(NVidia or Radeon)

If your answer is "YES"

Follow steps "1" to NVidia and "2" to Radeon.

If "NOT", go to STEP "3" or "4".

1. Nvidia Solution

The problem:

The game is running through the integrated chip.

To solve it we will need to put it in the list of processes of the video drive.

- 1) On the desktop, use the right mouse button.
- 2) Click the "Nvidia Control Panel"
- 3) A new drive management window will open.
- 4) Configuration 3D > Manage the settings in 3D
- 5) Find "Program Settings".
- 6) Click in "Add" and Find the "Main.exe".
- 7) On the graphics processor selection tab mark the video card (High-performance processor in case of notebooks).
- 8) Save and test.

2. Radeon Solution

The problem:

The game is running through the integrated chip.

To solve it we will need to put it in the list of processes of the video drive.

- 1) On the desktop, use the right mouse button.
- 2) Click the "Radeon (Catalyst) Drive"
- 3) Select tab "Power" or "Graphic Comutable".
- 4) Add the "Main.exe" on this list with option "High performance".

3. Integrated Chipset

Note:

If your processor is more than 5th generation and you use your integrated chip to play, unfortunately we will not be able to correct this problem.

The problem:

The game is running through the integrated chip.

To solve it we will need to put it in the list of processes of the video drive

- 1) First step: Uninstall current graphic drive.
 - 1.1) Press WINDOWS KEY + R (Execute)
 - 1.2)** Type : **devmgmt.msc**
 - 1.3) Find "Display Adapter"
 - 1.4) *Select Intel® HD Graphic (Version)*
 - 1.5) Click in Properties > Drive > Uninstall

- 2) Second step: Install new Drive.

Another simplified solution is:

Look for an official drive with a release date of up to the year 2014.

Install and open the game.
